









Directions to Clifton Science and Technology Campus

By train

Nottingham train station is five miles from Clifton Science and Technology Campus. A taxi would cost around £10 which you can get from either Carrington Street or Trent Street. You can also catch the Fo2 Uni 4 bus within term time from outside the station, this bus runs every seven minutes at peak times. Tickets cost £2.20 for a single trip or £4 for a day pass.

East Midlands Parkway is a 10 minute drive from Clifton Science and Technology Campus and a taxi would cost around £10.

By air

East Midlands Airport (EMA) is 10 miles from Clifton Science and Technology Campus, approximately a 15 minute drive. The Skylink bus service runs from the airport to Clifton and then Nottingham city centre, tickets cost £5 for a single and £8 return.

By tram

NTU Events and Conferencing has a discounted events ticket available for those delegates using the tram that runs from the city centre to Clifton. Southchurch Drive North is the closest stop to Clifton Campus which is then a 20 minute walk.

By car

When driving to Clifton Science and Technology Campus use postcode **NG11 8NS**, we have complimentary parking onsite.

The closest motorway junction is J24 on the M1. From J24 follow the A453 for seven miles. If you are travelling from the east follow the A52 and signs to Nottingham, then join the A453, signposted M1 South and our entrance will be on the right.

By bus

During term time the Go2 Uni 4 runs between our Nottingham City and Clifton Science and Technology campuses. Out of term time you can use the NCT 1 which picks up at Beastmarket Hill, Collin Street and Nottingham railway station and stops directly outside Clifton Campus.
