Brackenhurst Campus is located within 500 acres of beautiful Nottinghamshire countryside, bursting with greenery, woodlands and water creating the perfect rural setting for conferences, meetings and events.

The historic Grade II listed Main Hall overlooking the lake boasts beautiful lawns for outdoor receptions, marquees and team building events. By contrast the Bramley building has purpose built modern classrooms and the Lyth building boasts a 200-seater retractable lecture theatre, exhibition space, dining and drinks reception areas and a range meetings and breakout space. The Lyth is set to become a flagship venue in the rural and environmental sector.

Brackenhurst Campus is home to Nottingham Trent University's School of Animal, Rural and Environmental Sciences. It is the ideal partner for organisations supporting these industries looking to host meetings and conferences, or to present their products and services within a lecture theatre, exhibition space, classroom environment or outdoors.

By Car

When driving to Brackenhurst Campus the postcode is NG25 0QF. Brackenhurst is 14 miles north of the city centre with free parking available on site.

By Train

To get to Brackenhurst Campus by train travel to Nottingham Station in the city centre. After your train journey you will need to catch the 26 or 26A bus from King Street which stops directly outside Brackenhurst Campus.

By Bus

The 26 and 26A line from King Street, Nottingham city centre will take you directly to Brackenhurst Campus in 45 minutes.
