# How to find us

## By Car

When driving to Nottingham City Campus our postcode is NG1 4BU. There is no onsite parking but discount at a local car park is available for 8 and 24 hour stays. To claim this discount, tickets need to be purchased from reception before 5:30pm.

## By Train

Nottingham Station is a 15 minute walk from Nottingham City Campus. Alternatively you can get Nottingham's tram (NET) from the station with a £2.50 event return voucher obtained from us.

## By Air

East Midlands Airport is the closest airport to Nottingham City Campus which is 15 miles outside the city. There is a Skylink bus service running every half an hour into the city centre.

## By Tram

Park and Ride stations outside the city centre allow you to park and catch the tram to the Nottingham Trent University tram stop. Obtain a £2.50 return event voucher from us.
